PAYMENT BY CHEQUE

Payment by cheque is welcomed provided it is accompanied by a Cheque Guarantee Card which covers sums up to £50. Amounts to a higher figure are quite acceptable provided time is allowed for us to clear the cheque prior to the equipment being taken away. This will normally take 14 days unless a "special clearance" is arranged with the Bank which can be handled in 2/3 days. Goods may however, be taken away immediately should a Bankers Draft cheque be supplied.

CREDIT ACCOUNTS

As with most shops, we normally operate on the basis of cash and carry (or cash and drive). Credit Accounts can only be opened by customers dealing directly with our Head Office in Barnet, and a Credit Account would normally only be opened for Local Authorities, Universities, and other Government run organisations, or any other company of a substantial nature capable of a reasonable volume of annual trade with us to justify the operation of a Credit Account. Applications for Credit Accounts should be made in writing to our Company Head Office in Barnet, Hertfordshire, addressed for the attention of the Chief Accountant. Two trade references plus one Bank reference plus some indication concerning the likely level of annual trade would be required. Credit Accounts may not be operated through our local shops.

CLUB INSTALLATIONS

Roger Squire's is principally an equipment designer, manufacturer and major supplier. We always hold very large stocks of merchandise. We therefore advise all Club Managers and Properietors, whenever possible, to visit their nearest Roger Squire's Disco Centre to select the sound and lighting equipment most suitable to their needs. JINGLE MACHINES Choosing a jingle machine – and what ever happened to the 8 track?

The traditional NAB Jingle Machine is always the best method of playing Disco Jingles if you can afford one. The higher quality, and "auto-cue" facility make it ideal for discotheque applications. Good quality cassette machines are also a reliable method of playing jingles. We have however found that 8 track players and 8 track cartridges themselves, do not generally speaking, stand up to regular usage as well as cassette and NAB systems. We have therefore dropped 8 track players and 8 track jingles due to the unreliability problems experienced over the last few years.

CARTRIDGE RACKS

(Illustrated on page 21)

No more fumbling in the dark for that slippery NAB cartridge! Each tough plastic rack holds 6 cartridges, can be used either way up, stacked with others, or even mounted on a suitable surface.

Choosing a sound-to-lite controller

With 18 sound-to-lite controllers featured in this Catalogue the choice can be somewhat baffling. The first thing to recognise is that all the most reasonably priced equipment is 3 channel. A number of excellent controllers are available in this category but they will only offer you variations on conventional "sound-to-lite". If you want to have a really good "Chasing Effect" you must have either 4 channel, 6 channel or 10 channel. The 6 and 10 channel equipment is designed primarily for Club Installations but can be used on large Roadshows where the ultimate lighting system is required.

If you wish to use your sound-to-lite controller to operate projectors, pinspots, bullet beams, colour changers, scanner spots, helicopters, fuzzlites or neon displays, you *must* use a sound-to-lite controller designed for working into an inductive load. Failure to observe these guidelines will result in damage to your sound-to-lite controller. It is always wise to check compatibility with one of our service engineers before operating any lighting system other than a conventional one.

FAL RHYTHM LIGHT 3 channel

A budget controller, which will split the input from almost any amp into bass, middle and treble signals which individually activate the corresponding light channel. Maximum load per light channel is 750W. Circuit design features zero-voltage switching, channel separation enhancement and "Automatic Volume Control". AVC avoids the need for fiddling with sensitivity adjustors, because it constantly re-adjusts to changes in master volume/bass/mid/treble input levels.

Accepts inputs from 25W to 400W.

FAL AUTO SEQUENCER 3 channel

Will operate lights with a maximum loading of 1.2kW per channel. CHOOSING A LIGHTSHOW PROIECTOR

An important point to understand when making a choice concerns the type of bulb used by the projector. If you want the maximum light output and the longest life from your bulb, it should be of the Quartz Halogen variety. These normally operate on 12 or 24V and circumstances will need replacing every 20 hours, or thereabouts.


